



Do not exceed GVWR or GAWR, including blade and ballast. The rating label is found on the driver-side vehicle door cornerpost.

Read this document before installing the rubber deflector kit.


## **A** CAUTION

Use standard methods and practices when attaching snowplow and installing accessories, including proper personal protective safety equipment.


### **A** CAUTION

See your SnowEx<sup>®</sup> outlet/website for specific vehicle application recommendations before installation. The Power Match selection system has specific vehicle and snowplow requirements.

 Park the vehicle on a smooth, level, hard surface, such as concrete. Turn the vehicle ignition to the "OFF" position and remove the key. 2. Align the deflector on the blade, matching the holes in the deflector with the holes in the moldboard.



3. On 6'8", 8', and 8'6" blades, the deflector extends beyond the ends of the blade. Trim excess length from both ends of deflector and retainer bars as shown.



- Attach the retainer bars and deflectors to the blade using the supplied 5/16" x 1-1/4" cap screws, 5/16" washers, and 5/16" locknuts. Tighten the fasteners until the retainer bars are tight against the deflector.
- Touch up the paint on the ends of the retainer bars, using SnowEx<sup>®</sup> black enamel touch-up paint (not included).
